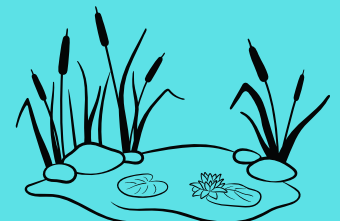
Willow Weaving - Pond Fence
