1 Nature stations

We will create nature themed mini-golf holes, with areas of wildflowers and pollinator plants, bee and bug homes and interpretation.



2 Carpet of spring flowers

Under the beech tree we will plant a carpet of spring flowering bulbs. Bluebells, anemones, crocus and daffodils will provide an important source of nectar for insects early in the year.



5 Flowering trees

A group of coastal flowering trees, such as rowan, will make a more welcoming entrance to the gardens. Birds will feast on the berries in the autumn.



During 2023-24 The Parks Foundation in partnership with BCP Council will be making changes to Boscombe Chine Gardens.

3 Wildflower meadow

We will create mini wildflower meadows at the pier entrance. Great for bees, bugs and butterflies, these will provide a home for our pollinators to feed and shelter in.



4 Bird & bat boxes

Installed throughout the park, these nesting boxes will help our local bats and birds thrive.
