Come and help with woodworking projects in the park. Tools provided. Suitable for teenagers and adults.



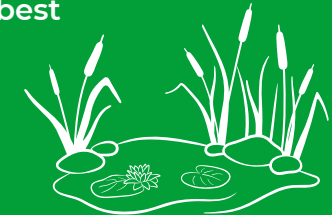
