Survey butterflies whilst learning about different species. The data will help us improve the parks for wildlife and increase butterfly numbers.

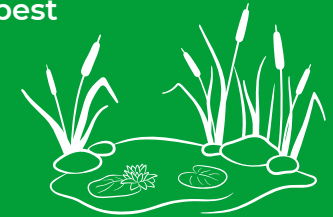
