Job Description

Job title: Café Supervisor/ Café and Mini Golf Supervisor

Salary: Minimum wage (e.g. £12.71 if over 21, £10.85 for 18-20) + holiday pay

Terms: Zero hours contract

Reporting to: Café Manager

Direct reports: Volunteers on shift

Job purpose: To support the Café Manager at our charity's community cafes. The role will involve the day-to-day management of the café operations with a focus on developing volunteers' skills and increasing park use and engagement. The café aims to operate in the most environmentally conscious way possible.

You will coordinate the daily running of the café, which is supported by volunteers, and assist with planned activities and events. You will be responsible for:

- Coordinating volunteers on a day-to-day basis
- Daily food hygiene routines
- Stock control and ordering stock
- Opening and closing cashing-up procedures
- Providing excellent customer service

- Assist with regular and seasonal events and activities when required.

Additional information:

- Weekend work will be required
- Any other duties as required by line manager
- You may be asked to work at other Parks Foundation cafes on occasions
